*The Graduate Academic Experience*

The Program offers **12 graduate credit hours**. Students have the option of selecting 4 of 5 courses, including a 300-contact hour internship. The internship component may be used to fulfill the UGA MPH required 6-credit internship. Each of the classes offered will also satisfy the requirements of the UGA **Graduate Certificate in Global Health**.

- Students will learn with University of Haifa students as well as students from other nations in class, creating a valuable learning experience with an international perspective.
- Internship sites (locations TBD) will offer students the chance to work in their field of study, while creating connections with Haifa students, Haifa faculty, and Israeli health professionals.
