

HEALTH INSURANCE

Medically necessary healthcare within the public health system of the Republic of Croatia (including the COVID-19/SARS-CoV-2 testing) is accessible to students from the **EU member states, the European Economic Area countries (EEA - Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein), and from Switzerland**. Those students exert their right by presenting their European Health Insurance Card (**EHIC**).

The same healthcare is available to students from the **contracting states** (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Turkey). Those students exert their right by presenting the appropriate **certificate issued by the authorized health insurance in their home countries**. The students are required to obtain the certificate **before** coming to Croatia.

All other students are required to **obtain adequate health insurance** to cover them during their stay in the Republic of Croatia. Those students should contact their health insurance provider for all information/questions regarding the coverage of their healthcare expenses while in the Republic of Croatia. Students can also register to **the Croatian Health Insurance Fund**.
